GLOBAL SPREAD CAUSES PANIC AND FEAR

Several hundred people, including many health-care workers, have died of the Mountain Associated Respiratory Syndrome (MARS) virus in Anycountry and its neighbouring country Nexdoria since the onset of the epidemic in early 2017. 27 imported cases have been confirmed in multiple countries around the world, including G20 countries. According to official reports, the number of new cases is rising continuously. Among the victims of the outbreak is a famous soccer player from Nexdoria.

STOCK MARKETS IN FREE FALL

Stock market values started dropping drastically after Anycountry officially declared a national emergency. Anycountry's local economy is in crisis, as the tourism industry has collapsed and import bans on products from the affected region have been imposed by several countries, despite WHO's recommendations against these measures.
