

Countries supported by G7 to implement the International Health Regulations (IHR)

The best protection against cross-border epidemics are resilient local health care systems. Therefore, at the 2015 G7 summit in Germany, the seven leading industrialised nations' (G7) Heads of State and Government agreed to help poorer countries implement the International Health Regulations within the next five years. The G7 have already pledged their support to 76 nations. Other countries can be added.
