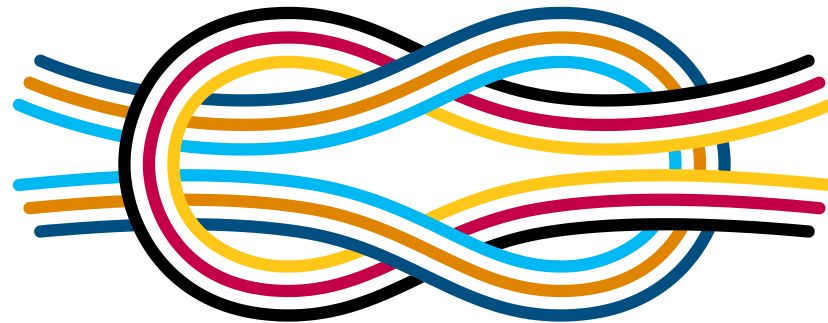

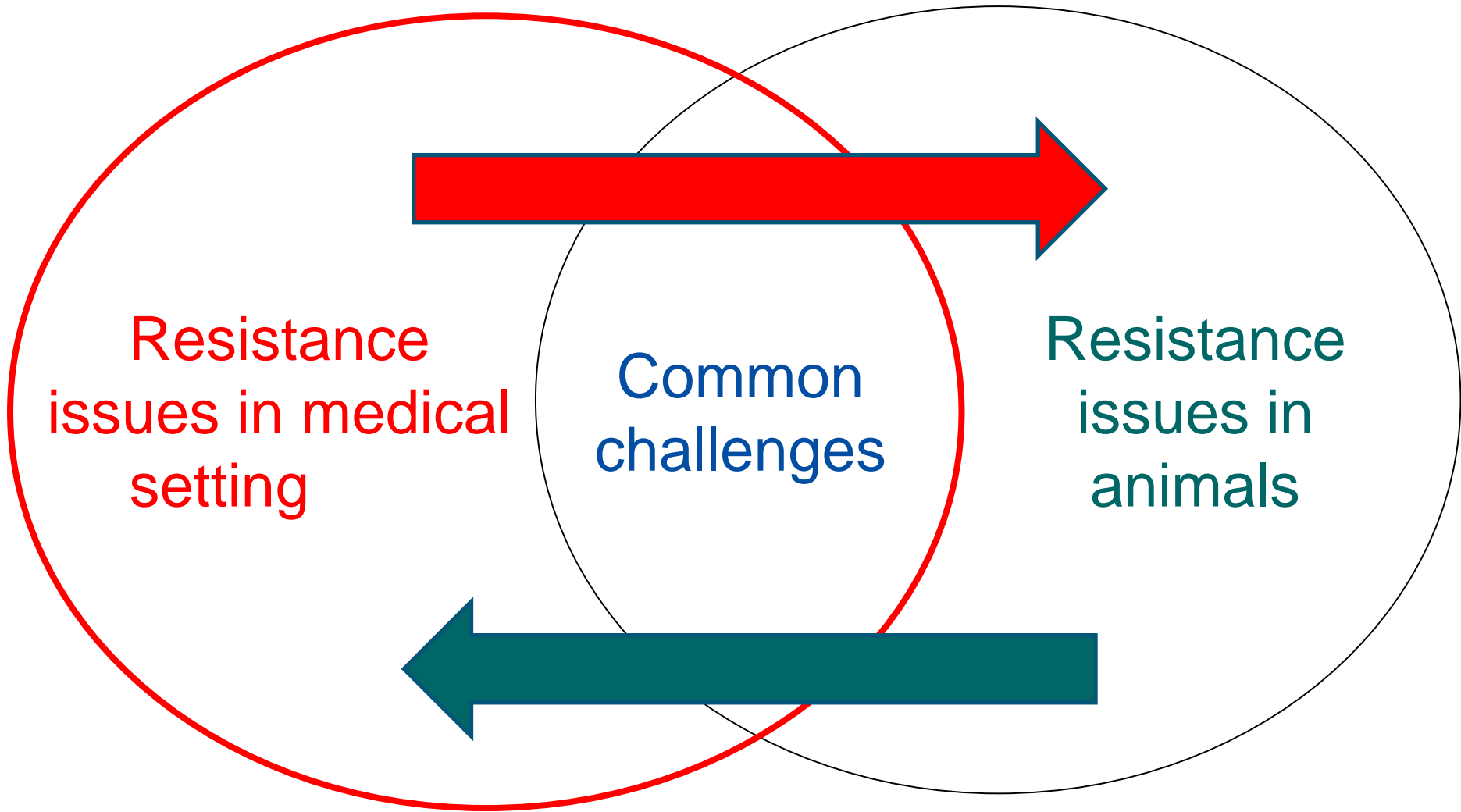

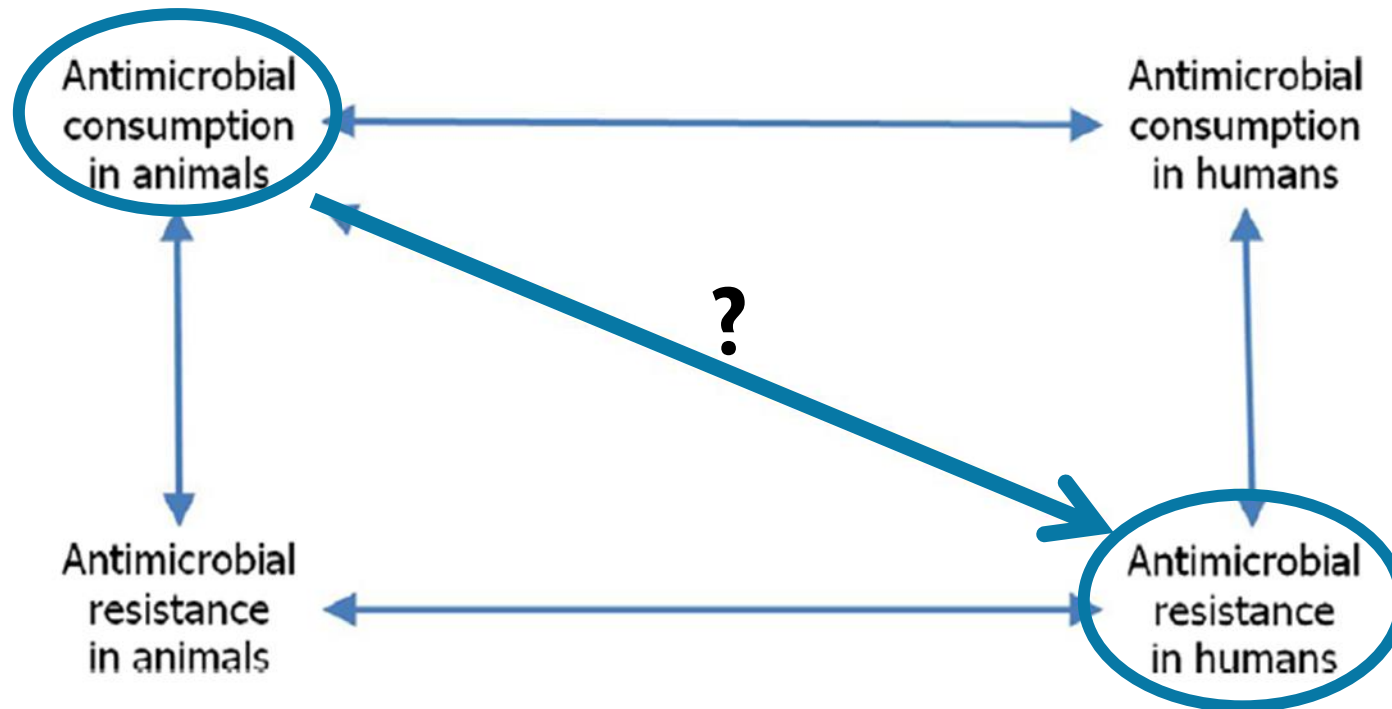
What is it all about?
